Fishermen landing fish to the fridge must comply with the necessary legislation.

All fisheries products must be identifiable to the vessel which landed it at any time. Once landed, fish must be identifiable to the vessel from which it originated. Before the first point of sale, fisheries products may move through a number of stages. To ensure traceability during this time, it is essential that the correct details are recorded and submitted throughout the chain.

The stages of the chain:

Landing

Weighing

Takeover

Transport

First sale of fish (sales notes)
