Mooring Alongside

Advice for tying off when alongside

Following an incident within St Ives Harbour the following advice has been issued

1. When mooring alongside it has been customary to use one short end, it is strongly recommended that the condition of this rope is checked often and replaced regularly.
2. It is recommended that at all times and especially in all conditions which are not considered benign that a second quay rope also be used.
3. If the vessel is to be left in gear it is recommended that the helm is lashed hard over and that a crewman is onboard at all times.
