Harbour Masters Notice 2022 – 09 Mooring Alongside

Advice for tying off when alongside

Following an incident within St Ives Harbour the following advice has been issued

- 1. When mooring alongside it has been customary to use one short end, it is strongly recommended that the condition of this rope is checked often and replaced regularly.
- 2. It is recommended that at all times and especially in all conditions which are not considered benign that a second quay rope also be used.
- 3. If the vessel is to be left in gear it is recommended that the helm is lashed hard over and that a crewman is onboard at all times.
