

TRURO HARBOUR

Works to Truro Tide Gates

Notice No. 11 of 2024

Mariners are advised that due to works to the Truro Tide Gates by the Environment Agency the stop logs need to be reinstalled from 1200hrs (noon) on Wednesday 18th September until 2200hrs on Saturday 21st September.

Navigation will be suspended, meaning you will be unable to pass through the tide gates during this time.

The following In-channel Risk Control Measures will be put in place, as agreed by the EA and the Truro Harbour Office:

- Flashing red Navigational Traffic Lights will be turned on during any in-channel operation and will remain on until operation is fully complete.
- Fenders lines will be put in place both upstream and downstream of the structure prior to starting.
- Tower lights will be in place and positioned illuminating the channel for works operation during darker hours.
- If the stop-logs are remaining within the channel, a watching brief will be put in place 3 hours before the subsequent high tide.
- An air-horn will be put in place to warn vessels of an obstruction within the channel. To warn approaching vessels, three long blasts on the air-horn, repeated if this warning is not acknowledged.
