NOTICE TO MARINERS

Notice No. 1 of 2026

Seal Camera Deployment near Turnaware Point

Location: River Fal, south-east of Turnaware Bar

Deployment Coordinates: ~ 50.2065/-5.0332


Mariners are advised that temporary scientific equipment including a seal monitoring camera system will be deployed in the waters near Turnaware bar, River Fal

Deployment is expected to begin week commencing 23rd February 2026, and the system will remain in place for a minimum of two weeks and no longer than one month (weather depending). A final notice will be issued upon retrieval of the system.

Deployment Details:

- A cylindrical camera unit (1.7m tall x 0.3m wide) will be suspended 1m above a seabed clump chain anchor, using a midwater buoy (approx. 0.6m tall x 0.4m diameter) 0.3m above the camera system.
- The total vertical height of the system from seabed to buoy is approximately 3.5 metres.
- A 12-metre vertical line with several small midwater floats connects the system to a red visual surface marker buoy.
