HARBOUR MASTER'S NOTICE

Notice No. 6 of 2026

Safe Petrol Fuelling Procedures

All persons involved in petrol fuelling are required to comply with the latest version of the St Ives Harbour Safe Fuelling Procedure (Petrol) at all times when dispensing petrol within the harbour.

Petrol is highly flammable and volatile, presenting a significantly greater risk of fire and explosion than diesel. Vapours can ignite easily and travel considerable distances to ignition sources. Extreme caution must be exercised at all times.

Petrol spills and vapours pose a serious fire, health, and environmental hazard. All users have a duty to minimise risk and protect the harbour environment.

Failure to comply with this notice and applicable national regulations may result in:

- Immediate suspension of fuelling operations
- Removal or revocation of mooring licences in the interest of public safety
- Further enforcement action in accordance with the Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment Regulations 2009

Petrol handling requires heightened awareness and discipline. Your cooperation is essential to ensure the safety of all harbour users, staff, and facilities.
